Checklist – Bring the following items to validation:

1. Bring the attached Rabbit Validation form completed.
2. Bring the BCYLS livestock entry form completed for market rabbits – find online at <https://www.bcyla.net/wp-content/uploads/2019/01/2019-BCYLS-LIVESTOCK-Entry-Form.pdf>
3. Must have child's social security number on the second page of BCYLS livestock entry form.
4. Bring ALL rabbits that you could possibly enter in the show. *Each rabbit must have personal tattoos in the left ear by validation and be in line by 6pm.*
5. Bring payment for each pen of rabbits (\$20/pen) entered and BCYLS membership dues (\$10/member).

Welcome to the BCYLS Market Rabbit Validation. You should have brought every rabbit that you might use in your market pen(s) to be validated. Each of your rabbits will be tattooed in the right ear with the BCYLS show validation tattoo.

By participating in validation, you will automatically be signed up to participate in the Rabbit Showmanship. Although participation is not mandatory for Rabbit Showmanship, all participants are encouraged to take part in this event at the show. Showmanship will follow the market rabbit show.

All rabbits must also have individual permanent ear marks (personal tattoos) applied to their left ear by validation. These marks are required for check-in at the show and must match the tag numbers listed on the validation form.

Any rabbit not having the appropriate validation tattoo and personal tattoo at check-in will be disqualified. This will result in the pen being disqualified.

Personal tattoos have to be applied prior to validation. Your breeder should be able to help you with this process.

EXHIBITOR: I understand that failure to have a permanent ear mark (personal tattoo) in each of my rabbits' left ears is an ARBA (American Rabbit Breeder's Association) disqualification. I also understand that having an ear mark that is not clearly readable is also a disqualification. I further understand that failure to have the BCYLS show validation in my rabbits' right ears is a BCYLS disqualification. If I fail to have each rabbit properly tattooed, I understand that my rabbit pen will be disqualified.
